2	Consumer Protection	Create the Department of Financial Protections and Innovation (DFPI).	2020-2021 State Budget includes intent language to create DFPI in the fall.	NextGen Supporting
3	Criminal Justice	Provide increased funding for the State Public Defender's Office and local county Public Defender offices.	\$14 million included the 2020-21 state budget.	NextGen Supported
4	Education	Create a student debt work group under the California Student Aid Commission.	\$250,000 included in 2020-21 state budget.	NextGen Supported
5	Food Insecurity	Provide funding to create the Farm to School pilot program under the Department of Food and Agriculture.	\$10 million included in 2020-21 state budget.	NextGen Supported
6	Food Insecurity	Increase funding for healthy school meals.	\$112 million of emergency COVID-19 funding in 2020-21 education omnibus bill.	NextGen Supported
